SCHEDULING INFORMATION

Please read over the following items before scheduling your presentation(s).

- Otto presentations are best suited for children ages 4 through 7 however, there are some opportunities for slightly older children to benefit from the presentation as well.
- Otto works best with groups of 50 children or less. This allows more children to interact with Otto and helps keep them engaged.
- Otto's operator needs to be able to see Otto and the first row of children at all times, yet be hidden from the children's view. This helps the children concentrate on Otto's message
- The ideal location is a cafeteria or gymnasium with a curtained stage, so that Otto and the children can be stationed on the floor, while Otto's operator can hide behind the curtains, peering through the opening.
- The larger the space that Otto has to maneuver, the more engaged the students will remain.
- Otto cannot be transported up and down multiple steps.
- No equipment is required; however, a designated adult, at the front of the room, is required to assist with the program by ensuring the children maintain a safe distance and/or helping call on volunteers.
