Your child has expressed a desire to serve in the School Safety Patrol. Service in Patrol is voluntary and open to all interested students. Duties will require a short amount of time each day. Members are selected for their leadership, courtesy, dependability, interest in their job, physical fitness, attitude toward others and scholastic standing.

The primary aims of the Patrol are:

- To help children cross streets safely on their way to and from school.
- To help children become safe pedestrians.
- To foster qualities of leadership and good citizenship in Patrol members.

School Safety Patrol membership is an honored position. Millions of boys and girls have served since the program started around 1920. Since then, the casualty record among children aged 5 to 14 has improved significantly. Patrols have played an important role in this achievement.

The Safety Patrol follows an award/demerit system to ensure students maintain the high standards of the program. Student receiving several demerits - for failing schoolwork, classroom discipline, being late for duty assignments, etc. - may be temporarily suspended from the Patrol. If disciplinary action is necessary, your full cooperation will be appreciated.

With your endorsement, your child will shoulder responsibilities that will strengthen character and provide an opportunity to help fellow students develop a better understanding of pedestrian and vehicular traffic hazards.
